Opportunity Scholarship

PURPOSE



The PowerED Opportunity Scholarship has been established to support individuals interested in pursuing a career in technology, who may face financial barriers.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the PowerED Opportunity Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Residency: Applicants must currently reside in Canada.
- 2. Legal Status:
 - Canadian Citizenship: Applicants must be Canadian citizens.
 - Permanent Residency: Applicants must be permanent residents of Canada.
 - Protected Person: Applicants who have been granted refugee status in Canada are eligible.
- 3. Work Authorization: Applicants must be legally entitled to work in Canada.
- 4. Age: Applicants must be at least 18 years old.
- 5. Language Proficiency: Applicants must be proficient in English.

 Documentation may be requested if secondary or post-secondary education was not completed in English.
- 6. Admission Tests and Interview: Applicants must successfully pass the training program admission tests and interview.
- 7. Commitment: Applicants must understand the dedication and commitment required to complete the intensive retraining program offered.





PURPOSE



Scholarship Details

- Scholarship Amount: \$6,000 CAD per recipient (bringing the total program cost down to \$6,495).
- Validity: Scholarship is only valid for courses starting in 2024. **Limited** quantities are available and the scholarship may end at any time.

Selection Process

- Applications will be reviewed on an ongoing basis.
- Evaluation criteria include financial need, language proficiency, and readiness for the program.
- Recipients will be notified within 2 weeks of application submission.

Application Process

- Applications must be submitted here.
- Supporting documentation (e.g., proof of residency, legal status) may be required.
- Personal statement (max. 500 words) should outline career goals and how the scholarship will support achievement.
